

# NOTICE OF RACE

International Starboat Class 13<sup>th</sup> District Championship  
Hellerup, Denmark 8 – 10 June 2018  
Helleup Sailing Club, Denmark  
Host fleet: Danish fleet



*The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.*

## 1. Rules

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the applying prescriptions of the national authority and Nordic Sailing Federation, will be incorporated into the sailing instructions. The Organizing Authority is Hellerup Sailing Club in conjunction with the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (ISCYRA). The host fleet is the Danish Fleet.
- 1.2 The rules of the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (STCR) will apply.
- 1.3 RRS 32 will be changed to provide that courses will not be shortened.
- 1.4 RRS 33(b) will not apply.
- 1.5 RRS 35 will be changed to provide that boats not finishing within 60 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored "Did Not Finish" without a hearing.
- 1.6 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.7 RRS 60.1(a) will be changed to a boat can not protest against some parts of the sailing instructions.
- 1.8 RRS 61.1(b) will be changed to protests from race or protest committee needs only to be notices on the official noticeboard.
- 1.9 RRS 62.2 will be changed to shorten the time for requesting regress.
- 1.10 RRS 63.1 will be changed to provide that a boat failing to check in prior to the warning signal will be scored the same as a boat not starting in that race without a hearing.
- 1.11 RRS A4 and A5 will be changed to a boat not starting within 10 minutes after the starting signal will be scored "Did Not Start".
- 1.12 In accordance with STCR 31.2.6. The race committee may broadcast race information on VHF channel 72 before and during each race. Failure of such information to be given or received, or the order in which OCSs calls are broadcasted, shall not be grounds for redress, except when a request for redress under this instruction is initiated by the race committee or the jury. This changes RRS 62.1.

## 2. Advertising

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

## 3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 Entries eligible in accordance with STCR 21, 26, 29 and 30 may compete.
- 3.2 Entries shall be submitted on the official online entry form not later than 15<sup>th</sup> May to the organizing authority.
- 3.3 Only skippers and crew eligible to compete under World Sailing Eligibility Code shall be eligible to compete in this regatta.
- 3.4 For the purpose of RRS A Scoring: A competitor is not considered an entry until: (a) All fees are paid and (b) measurement is completed.

## 4. Fees

The entry fee of €175 includes boat and trailer parking, launching, hauling and invitations to social events for skipper and crew. Payment online via [Manage2sail.com](http://Manage2sail.com)

## **5. Schedule**

- 5.1 Registration/check-in: Launching and weighing of crew will be 8 June 2018 between 0800 to 1200.
- 5.2 7 (seven) races are scheduled for the regatta.
- 5.3 2 races are scheduled Friday 8 June 2018 with first warning signal at 1400.
- 5.4 3 races are scheduled Saturday 9 June 2018 with first warning signal at 1100.
- 5.5 2 races are scheduled Sunday 10 June 2018 with first warning signal at 1000.
- 5.6 No warning signal shall be given after 1300 Sunday 10 June 2018.
- 5.7 Price giving ceremony shortly after closing of protest time and eventual hearings.

## **6. Measurement**

- 6.1 Measurement and weight certificates will be checked at the race office. Each participating boat shall have a valid measurement- and weight certificate.
- 6.2 Weighing of skipper and crew will have to be done not later than 1 hour before first race
- 6.3 Each boat shall show the sail number and national letters as indicated on the official entry form.
- 6.4 A boat shall comply with RRS 78.1 before the end of the regatta.

## **7. Sailing Instructions**

The sailing instructions will be available Friday, 8 June 2018.

## **8. Courses**

Courses will be according to STCR 34.

## **9. Venue**

Racing will be conducted on the waters of Øresund, just outside Helleup.

## **10. Scoring**

- 10.1 3 (three) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.2 The Low Point Scoring System, RRS A, will apply, modified so that each series score will be the total of her races scores with her worst score excluded if more than four (4) races are completed.

## **11. Haul-out Restrictions**

The Organizing Authority may impose haul-out restrictions.  
Crane will be available from Thursday morning 8 June 2018. The use of crane at your own risk. The club cannot be held liable for any damages. There might be a second crane in Skovshoved harbour. [DP]

## **12. Diving Equipment and Plastic Pools**

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keelboats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta. [DP]

## **13. Radio Communication**

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

## **14. Team and Private Support Boats**

A yacht shall receive no outside assistance from support boats or otherwise once she has left the dock for the day until the finish of the last race of the day, except in the case of emergency and/or towing supplied by the organizer and available to all participants. . [DP]

**15 Prizes**

There will be a prize for the winner of the Event. Furthermore daily first, small Prizes. Today's leader, BIB yellow.

**16. Disclaimer**

The Organizing Authority shall require each competitor to sign a waiver for loss, damage or injury to persons or property occurring in conjunction with the regatta or on the part of the Organizing Authority their members, employees, officers and/or agents shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur to person or property whether ashore or on the water as a consequence of the participation of any boat.

**17. Insurance**

17.1 Boats sailing in this regatta (each 'person in charge' see RRS 46) must be adequately insured and shall hold a valid insurance certificate showing proof of third party liability for racing risks, with a minimum cover of 1 million Euro per event or the equivalent.

17.2 The Organizing Authority is not responsible for verifying the status or validity of certificates.
